

GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF TENTS

For The Sunday Artisan Market

Revised: February 24, 2013

Guidelines for tent usage:

1. Any vendor wishing to put up a tent **MUST** have prior approval from the Market Manager prior to their first day at the market.
2. A vendor must rent two spaces in order to put up a tent.
 - a. Please note that not all vendor spaces at the market can accommodate the usage of tents.
3. The tent must be adequately weighted or otherwise secured so as not to become a hazard in the wind. A safety inspection will be conducted by the market manager for approval. If viewed as hazardous, the vendor may be asked to remove the tent.
4. The tent must be situated in the center of the two spaces to allow space on either side for water run-off, neighbor's vehicles, etc.
5. A vendor using their parking area for a tent must move their vehicle to the dirt lot or to the Community High parking lot across 5th Ave.
6. Tents may not exceed 10 feet by 10 feet square.
7. Tents must be flame retardant.
8. Any vendor that chooses to use their tent space to sell additional product will be charged a \$10 fee – not to exceed \$200 per season.
